IDEAS:

- Use key words at key times. Incorporate the word privacy into patients' routine care such as asking the patient if they
 would like their door closed for privacy or letting him/her know, "For your privacy I'm closing the door."
- Design patient registration areas to provide a panel between desks, affording more patient privacy during the registration process.
- Arrange nurses' stations so that patient names or medical records are not visible to the passerby.
- Create signage to be placed on each room's door reminding staff to be mindful of patient privacy.
- In the Outpatient Lab setting, separate draw stations with solid walls.
